Description

This project entailed the construction of a new office and secure entrance to the school. The coursed limestone construction of the existing building was matched to a high degree, with natural stone sourced from the quarry in Dove Holes itself, then dressed and coursed on site. Gritstone quoins, cills, lintels and jambs were incorporated to achieve an overall effect that matched the existing building.
